Trend in Federal Data Requirements



- ✓ Recently, federal programs have embraced a common theme of data-driven decision making and the creation of a culture of evidence to promote formative program improvement.
- ✓ However, there are many challenges in gathering accurate and timely data, interpreting evaluation findings, and using the results to effect program improvement.

Why is this important?



- ✓ Accurate and timely data is needed to:
 - ensure compliance with DOE requirements re: program administration
 - examine program processes and promote continuous improvement
 - inform stakeholders of the effectiveness of GEAR UP and the services it provides nationwide









Common Barriers



✓ Program components that often present challenges to effective evaluation:



- Administering & Processing Surveys
- Collecting Service Participation Data
- Collecting Student-Level Academic Data
- Completing the APR
- Using Data to Inform Decision Making

Challenge: Using Data for Informed Decision Making Example: Mentoring

- ✓ **Objective 4:** % of GEAR UP students who graduate from high school will increase.
- ✓ Objective 5: % of GEAR UP students who are enrolled in college will increase to 10% by June 2018.
- ✓ Objective 8: 80% (or higher) of GEAR UP students and their parents will demonstrate increased knowledge of available financial aid, and costs / benefits of pursuing postsecondary education.

Mentoring Retention

Less than 20% Retention



Compass System



What is Compass?

A secure data management and evaluation tool that expedites data entry, organizes program data, generates reports and conducts statistical analysis to evaluate program success. Compass Features:

- ✓ Customized data entry screens
- ✓ Automated participation reports
- ✓ Batch entry for documenting group activities
- ✓ Automatic computation of data for required reports



Compass System



Challenge: Obtaining and entering student academic data.

Solution: Data electronically transferred into the system.

Challenge: Time-consuming hand-entry of services and activities data.

Solution: Screens designed for speed and accuracy.

Challenge: Collecting and organizing data for required reports.

Solution: Automatically computes and exports such data.

Challenge: Lack of expertise/resources to conduct impact analyses.

Solution: Conducts statistics & displays results in graphs and tables.
